- Advised and represented Teva Pharmaceuticals on a patent dispute before the Finnish Market Court concerning Bristol-Myers Squibb Holdings Ireland Unlimited Company's ("BMS") patent and supplementary protection certificate ("SPC") for the blockbuster drug apixaban, marketed under the brand name Eliquis. The Market Court handed down a ruling in the joined invalidity and infringement cases in May 2024 declaring BMS' patent and related SPC invalid and dismissing BMS' infringement action against Teva. Consequently, the preliminary injunction imposed against Teva was cancelled.
- Advised and represented OPPO, a leading global smart device brand, and its subsidiary OnePlus Technology, a globally operating consumer electronics manufacturer, on their standard essential patent litigation against Nokia Corporation. The dispute related to multiple patents-in-suit and 4G/5G telecommunications standard and FRAND (fair, reasonable and non-discriminatory) license terms in between the parties.
- Advised and represented TomTom International, a leading location technology service provider, listed on Euronext Amsterdam in the Netherlands, in a patent dispute against Nokia Corporation. The Finnish Market Court dismissed Nokia's action without considering its merits in accordance with the request from TomTom and a codefendant.
- Advised and represented Mylan before the Court of Justice of the European Union in case C-473/22 (Mylan v. Gilead and Others) in which the Court of Justice handed down its judgement in January 2024. The case concerned the Finnish compensation regime that can be invoked when a preliminary injunction is found to have been unfounded. This compensation regime is based on the concept of strict liability.
- Advised Detection Technology on various complex matters relating to intellectual property rights, re-search and development, technology transfer and manufacturing in the MEMS sensor technology, including contractual matters, transactions and patent law advice.
- Advised and represented SodaStream, a globally renowned manufacturer and seller of home carbonation machines, in a trademark infringement dispute before the Court of Justice of the European union in the case C-197/21 (SodaStream v. MySoda). The case relates to the so-called exhaustion of trademark rights, a legal principle fully harmonized within the EU. The case is of particular interest as the Court of Justice clarified the trademark proprietor's legitimate reasons to oppose further commercialization of its branded goods even in the situation where the trademark proprietor's exclusive trademark rights would have been consumed, and the principle of exhaustion would be applied. The same dispute was pending also before the Finnish Supreme Court which confirmed the counter party's trademark infringement in its ruling (case KKO:2023:87).

- Advised and represented Vaisala, a global leader in the field of environmental and industrial measurement technology, in a patent dispute before the Finnish Market Court. The dispute concerned a European patent on a weather radar technology used in meteorological observations. Vaisala won the case, and the patent-in-suit was revoked.
- Advised and represented Orifarm, Denmark's largest supplier of pharmaceuticals, in a trademark dispute concerning the packaging of pharmaceutical products. The court rejected all claims of the counterparty and awarded damages to Orifarm due to the unnecessary preliminary injunction granted in the matter. In the appeal proceedings, the first instance judgement was held and it was confirmed that Orifarm's packaging fulfilled the requirements for repackaging of pharmaceutical products under the practice of the Court of Justice of the European Union (the so-called BMS criterion).
- Advised and represented Hospira, the world's leading provider of injectable drugs and
 infusion technologies, in a complex patent litigation case regarding medicine
 docetaxel with a commercial value of several millions of euros. Outcome of the dispute
 was that the adverse party's patent-in-suit was revoked and Hospira's product was
 confirmed to be non-infringing.
- Advised and represented successfully a major Nordic insurance company in complex and extensive arbitration proceedings against one of the largest Nordic IT system suppliers in a dispute involving an interest of several millions of euros concerning the failed supply of an IT system.
